

VOLUNTEER POSITIONS

DESCRIPTION AND REQUIREMENTS

Position	Description	Requirements
Cart Scorers	Assigned to a group and tasked with driving a golf cart, recording the scores for each player in the group and radioing these scores to Scoring Central.	Must possess valid Driver's License and be able to operate two-way radio. Basic Golf knowledge and etiquette preferred.
Scoring Central	Responsible for receiving radio calls from each cart scorer and recording these scores in a computer.	Basic two-way radio and computer skills are preferred
Player Shuttles	Responsible for shuttling players and caddies to specified locations throughout the golf course.	Must possess valid Driver's License; Basic Golf knowledge and etiquette preferred.
Driving Range / Caddie Tent	Responsible for assembling and distributing caddie bibs to caddies at the caddie tent, filling/refilling range stations with range balls.	Moderate lifting may be required
Guest Starters	Announces players on the 1st or 10th tee, distributes scorecards and statistic cards, and gives last minute information to players.	Strong voice/public speaking skills preferred
Marshals	Assist with minimizing potential distractions caused by fans attending the tournament. Direct cart traffic in heavily congested areas or blind approaches to tee, fairway or green.	
Spotters	Act as "forecaddies" or "advance scouts" by assisting the professionals in locating wayward golf shots. Stationed near a fairway or a green, spotters watch each shot and help locate a ball in situations where the player may not have a clear view of the ball's final resting position.	
Standard Bearers	Standard Bearers walk the course and carry a standard sign which includes the names and scores of the players in a specific group. They confirm each player's score with the Cart Scorer and update scores on the sign as play progresses for all 18 holes.	Required to walk and carry the weight of a standard sign (10-15 pounds) for all 18 holes
Volunteer Services / Hospitality	Greet and register other volunteers, provide general information, and assist with shuttling volunteers to/from their assigned area and distributing volunteer food and beverage.	
Ecology	Responsible for the active distribution of bottled water to designated areas. Collection and replacement of trash bags at all trash bin locations. May also assist with water cooler and trash bin placement before the tournament and collection after the tournament.	Heavy lifting may be required.
Caddie Bib Collection	Responsible for collecting the caddie bibs from the caddies after the second round and final round of the tournament. This position is typically located next to 9 & 18 green.	Walking and standing may be required due to some caddies may walk a different direction from where the caddie bib return in located.
